

# TASTING NOTES: DRAUGHT BEERS

<b>Diemen's Brew</b>	<b>Lager</b>	<b>France</b>	<b>4.7%</b>	<b>1.70</b>	<b>3.10</b>	<b>5.90</b>	<b>3.90</b>
Diemen's Brew is a lager brewed especially to our own special recipe by one of the oldest and most respected French breweries. Finely balanced flavours of grain and hops, make an extremely refreshing and drinkable session beer.							
<b>Pilia</b>	<b>Lager</b>	<b>France</b>	<b>5.2%</b>	<b>1.80</b>	<b>3.30</b>	<b>6.40</b>	<b>4.40</b>
Awarded in the "France Beer Challenge 2019" contest, Pilia is a French Lager style easy drinking beer. Very balanced, it comes from the know-how of the two brewers: François and Guillaume. Pure malt, unpasteurized, this Lager is filtered to reveal a beautiful golden color.							
<b>Finbarra</b>	<b>Cider</b>	<b>Ireland</b>	<b>5.0%</b>	<b>1.90</b>	<b>3.60</b>	<b>6.90</b>	<b>4.90</b>
A classic premium Irish cider that draws on the tannic bittersweet heritage of Dabinett & Michelin apple varieties grown in Laois and Waterford orchards. Crisp, puckering with a gentle astringency softened by the fresh eating apple juice used to back sweeten complete the cider; if your palate veers to the dry, this is the one for you.							
<b>O'Haras Red Ale</b>	<b>Red Ale</b>	<b>Ireland</b>	<b>4.3%</b>	<b>1.90</b>	<b>3.60</b>	<b>6.90</b>	<b>4.90</b>
Originating from the traditional Irish Brewery Carlow Brewing, O'Haras beer balances the sweet aroma of caramel with the bitterness of hops. Dressed in a ruby color under a white foam, it delivers sweet and fruity notes. The addition at the end of the preparation of a pinch of roasted barley brings a distinctive note to the beer.							
<b>Erdinger</b>	<b>Weissbier</b>	<b>Germany</b>	<b>5.5%</b>	<b>1.90</b>	<b>3.60</b>	<b>6.90</b>	<b>4.90</b>
Erdinger Weissbier is a classic German wheat beer, or Weissbier with an impressive array of aromas and flavours. Brewed by Erdinger in the heart of Bavaria, this Weissbier shows off a pale blonde body capped by an abundant creamy white head. The bouquet is full of classic banana and cloves, with citrus fruit and light wheat malt notes. This spicy banana and clove character reappears on the palate, with more citrus and spice that make this complex German Witbier a truly satisfying drop.							
<b>12 Acres Pale Ale</b>	<b>American Pale Ale</b>	<b>Ireland</b>	<b>5.2%</b>	<b>2.00</b>	<b>3.80</b>	<b>7.40</b>	<b>5.40</b>
The sweetness of the malt is balanced with American hops; Cascade, Willamette and Citra, with three additions to the boil to give that distinctive American Pale Ale bitterness and citrus flavour. This pale ale is also dry hopped to give a lovely tropical fruit aroma to the finished beer. It goes great with spicy foods!							
<b>51st State IPA</b>	<b>IPA</b>	<b>Ireland</b>	<b>6.0%</b>	<b>2.00</b>	<b>3.80</b>	<b>7.40</b>	<b>5.40</b>
Bursting with bold tropical flavours of grapefruit, passion fruit, apricot and peach, this unfiltered IPA, which takes its inspiration from the New England IPA style, is an attack on the senses. A carefully chosen hop blend provides an intense citrus aroma while adding a well-balanced yet mild bitterness. Malts are combined to deliver a smooth mouthfeel.							
<b>Fidèle</b>	<b>Lager</b>	<b>France</b>	<b>5.0°</b>	<b>2.00</b>	<b>3.80</b>	<b>7.40</b>	<b>5.40</b>
Light blonde, slightly golden colour, very representative of lager beers. It pours with a pure and fine white foam that has a long hold on the glass. Light and fresh attack that then gives way to citrus notes of hops.							
<b>Grimbergen Rouge</b>	<b>Fruity</b>	<b>Belgium</b>	<b>6.0%</b>	<b>2.00</b>	<b>3.80</b>	<b>7.40</b>	<b>5.40</b>
Flavoured with red fruits, subtly combines the character of an Abbey beer with the sweetness and aromas of strawberry, cranberry and elderberry in its taste. Its purple colour with intense reflections and its slightly pink foam indicates a unique fruity beer flavour.							

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<b>Hoegaarden</b>	<b>Blanche</b>	<b>Belgium</b>	<b>4.9%</b>	<b>2.00</b>	<b>3.80</b>	<b>7.40</b>	<b>5.40</b>
Hoegaarden Belgian Wheat Beer has a distinctive taste - with a fruity character, interlaced with subtle spice, it is aromatic with hints of clove, coriander and gently refreshing citrus notes. A sweet vanilla, lightly smoky flavour is the finishing touch. Lightly sweet and sour and perfectly balanced							
<b>Guinness</b>	<b>Stout</b>	<b>Ireland</b>	<b>4.2%</b>	<b>2.20</b>	<b>4.10</b>	<b>7.90</b>	<b>5.90</b>
Guinness has a malty sweetness and a hoppy bitterness, with notes of coffee and chocolate. A roasted flavor also comes through, courtesy of the roasted unmalted barley that goes into its brewing. It has a sweet nose, with hints of malt breaking through, and its palate is smooth, creamy, and balanced.							
<b>Pietra</b>	<b>Ambrée</b>	<b>Corsica</b>	<b>6.0%</b>	<b>2.20</b>	<b>4.10</b>	<b>7.90</b>	<b>5.90</b>
Beer with character worthy of a Corsican, this Pietra Ambrée worthily represents the traditions of the island of beauty since it is brewed on site and with a typical ingredient of the island; chestnut flour. It is used in addition to barley malts usually used to produce beer! The Pietra is an amber-colored beer that is topped with a thin layer of foam and offers malty aromas accompanied by woody scents and discrete notes of chestnut. It delivers a strong aroma of hops.							
<b>La Bete Ambrée</b>	<b>Ambrée</b>	<b>France</b>	<b>8.0%</b>	<b>2.30</b>	<b>4.30</b>	<b>8.40</b>	<b>6.40</b>
With a name like that, La Bete could only be a strong beer. Its amber colour underpins a thin but dense white foam. In the mouth, its malty character is immediately imposed, accompanied by delicious notes of caramel and gingerbread. Its subtle bitterness makes it quite accessible despite its 8 percent.							
<b>La Chouffe</b>	<b>Blonde Ale</b>	<b>Belgium</b>	<b>8.0%</b>	<b>2.30</b>	<b>4.30</b>	<b>8.40</b>	<b>6.40</b>
La Chouffe leaves citrus notes on the palate, followed by a refreshing, pleasantly spicy note, giving it a lovely lightness. With its 8% alcohol content and slightly hoppy taste, this golden beer has won over beer lovers from all over the world down the years. Its unique taste has won various awards.							
<b>Bon Secours 4 Houblon</b>	<b>IPA</b>	<b>Belgium</b>	<b>5.9%</b>	<b>2.40</b>	<b>4.60</b>	<b>8.90</b>	<b>6.90</b>
Bon Secours 4 Houblons (5.9%) is a light beer with character. The Nugget, Centennial, Cascade and Belma hops give it a nice rich taste as well as a pronounced bitterness.							
<b>Bon Secours Myrtille</b>	<b>Fruity</b>	<b>Belgium</b>	<b>7.0%</b>	<b>2.40</b>	<b>4.60</b>	<b>8.90</b>	<b>6.90</b>
This fruit beer has a rather dark red color in the glass, under a compact and slightly reddish foam. It gives off strong aromas of blueberries, as well as hops and a slight acidity. On the palate, we find a dry and refreshing beer with beautiful fruity flavors that confront a bitterness and a touch of alcohol more present than in classic fruit beers. A Belgian fruit beer not to be missed!							
<b>Tripel Karmeleit</b>	<b>Abbaye</b>	<b>Belgium</b>	<b>8.4%</b>	<b>2.40</b>	<b>4.60</b>	<b>8.90</b>	<b>6.90</b>
This three-grain beer brewed with Steiermark hops has good herbal flavours. It owes its fruity character (banana and vanilla) to the home-cultured yeast. The vanilla mingles with the orange-like aroma from the hops. Not only does it have the lightness and freshness of the wheat, it also has the creaminess of oats and a herbal, lemony dryness almost reminiscent of quinine.							
<b>Paix Dieu</b>	<b>Abbaye</b>	<b>Belgium</b>	<b>10.0%</b>	<b>2.70</b>	<b>5.10</b>	<b>9.90</b>	<b>7.90</b>
The limited production of Brasserie Caulier's Paix-Dieu, the only Abbaye beer brewed during a full moon, is strictly regulated by the lunar calendar. A traditionally produced artisanal tripel, Paix-Dieu is full of character thanks to carefully selected ingredients from local producers. Pouring hazy gold with a generous, creamy head, it breathes complex fruity, spicy scents including hops, malt, yeast and vanilla. On the tongue there are more soft hops flavours as well as fruit, yeast, coriander and spice notes.
